Area State & National Parks

It's easy to fall in love with the nature that the River Valley provides. The Arkansas River has been access points at Dwight Mission, Hilltop Boyou Park, Lake Dardanelle State Park, Ocala boat launch and Shiloh Park. Visitors and residents can enjoy fishing, eagle watching, and beautiful sunsets. Known as Lake for All Seasons, Lake Dardanelle is a 3,400-acre lake with 115 miles of shoreline. Russellville is part of the Arkansas River Valley Tri-Parks tourism region. It takes its name from three state parks: atop Mount Magazine, Mount Nebo and Pearl Jean Mammam. All just minutes from Russellville, these parks offer cabins, camping, fishing, swimming, rock climbing, disc golf, hiking trails, tennis, paddle boats, playgrounds, breathtaking scenery, hang gliding, waterfalls, or simply just enjoying the sound of nature.

- Camping located on both shores of Lake Dardanelle.
- Antler traps, standard provisions, picnic sheds, and bait can be obtained here.
- The Russellville area features a boater-free fishing pier, nature trail, fishing tournament weigh-in pavilion, interpretive program, lake tours, and kayak rentals.
- The park boast interpretive programs and events held month as well as 4th fishing tournament.
- Private-owned marinas and boat docks are located in both areas. The Russellville Marina offers boat repair, rental cabins, boats, & wave runners.

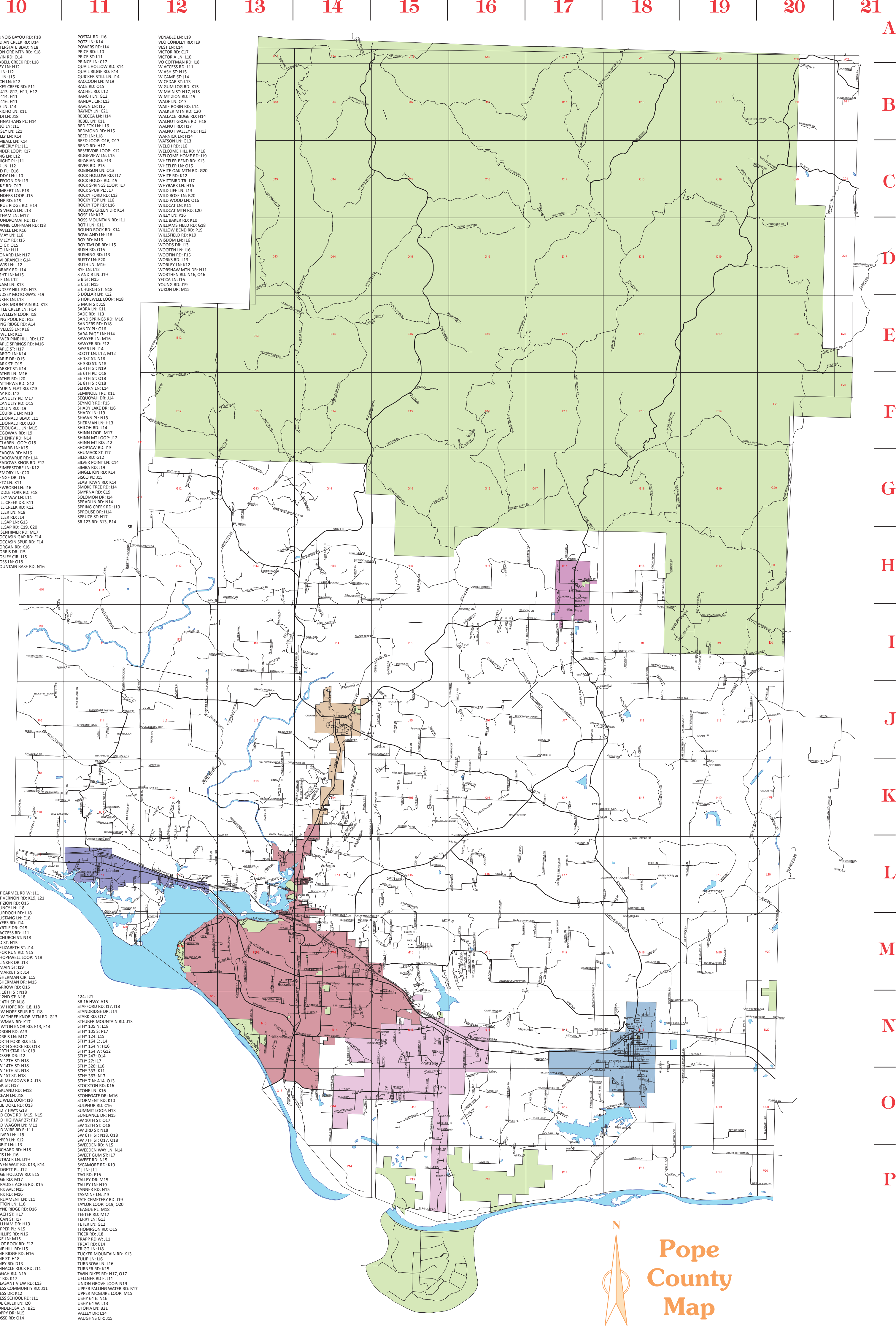
